



How to Use the Brainfuse Writing Lab

CREATING A BRAINFUSE LEARNING ACCOUNT

To use the Brainfuse Writing Lab, you will need to create a learning account.

1. Click on the blue sign up link.
2. Choose your username and type it in the box.
3. Choose your password, type it in the box and retype to confirm.
4. Choose a password hint question and answer.
5. Click next to register your account.

Important Notes: Brainfuse does not require any personal information when creating an account. Be sure to remember or write down your username and password.

SENDING YOUR DOCUMENT

1. It is our policy to not disclose any personal or confidential information to third parties. This policy notwithstanding, please do not submit any information that is personal and confidential, such as last names, phone numbers, and email or home addresses.

2. **Add comments**
Add any information that you think our writing expert should know before reviewing your paper.
3. **Upload your document**
This process may take a while depending on the size of your file and your connection speed.
4. **Receive your results**
Check the Message Center for our response (usually within one business day).

1. Click on the Writing Lab. (If you are not logged in, you will be prompted to do so.)
2. To attach the document you wish to send, click on Choose File. This will open a window where you can browse for the file on your computer or Cloudpack (Brainfuse virtual storage).
3. In the box you can add comments that will be helpful for your tutor while reviewing your paper. For example, you may want your tutor to focus on a particular aspect of your writing or explain the details of your assignment.
4. To send your file to the Brainfuse writing experts, click submit.
5. After submitting your paper, you will receive a message letting you know that the paper will be returned to your Brainfuse message center, usually within one business day.

RETRIEVING AND ABOUT YOUR FEEDBACK

1. In the message center, you will see your submissions and the feedback from your tutor. The tutor comments and any attached documents appear in the blue area.
2. At the top of the feedback you will see the tutor response including an overview and comments about your introduction & conclusion, development, organization, grammar and mechanics, and formatting.
3. As you scroll through your paper, you will see some specific comments throughout the text in a different color, usually blue and separated from your paper in brackets for easy review.


How to use Flashbulb

Brainfuse's versatile and comprehensive flashcard tool.

Flashbulb is located in the study section. The first time you access Flashbulb, you will be asked to either "Click Here" or login with your account. By clicking the button, a Flashbulb account will be automatically created for you and permanently linked to your Brainfuse Learning Account.

HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN FLASHBULB SET


1. After choosing Create on the banner, click on the Create New Flashbulb link. You will see 3 tabs across the top: Settings, Data, and Slides.



2. On the first tab, enter the name of your new Flashbulb set. Then enter a description. From the category dropdown, choose where you would like your set to appear on the Flashbulb page. If you do not want anyone to be able to edit your Flashbulb set, click the "prevent others from modifying data" box. If you do not wish for your cards to be available to others, select private as the category. Then click Save Changes.



3. Click on the data tab to start adding your questions and answers. After filling in a field, you can press Tab to move to the next one. When you get to the bottom of the form, you can keep hitting the Tab key to add more Questions and Answers. When you are finished adding your data, click Save Changes.



The slides tab gives you ability to create a labeled image activity, for example parts of a cell. After adding an image on the slides tab, you will add the names in the label box. Make sure you move each label to the correct place on your image.

4. Once a stack of cards has been created, you can interact with them in a variety of ways including both games and activities. Some examples are flashcards, hangman, matching, or unscramble.
